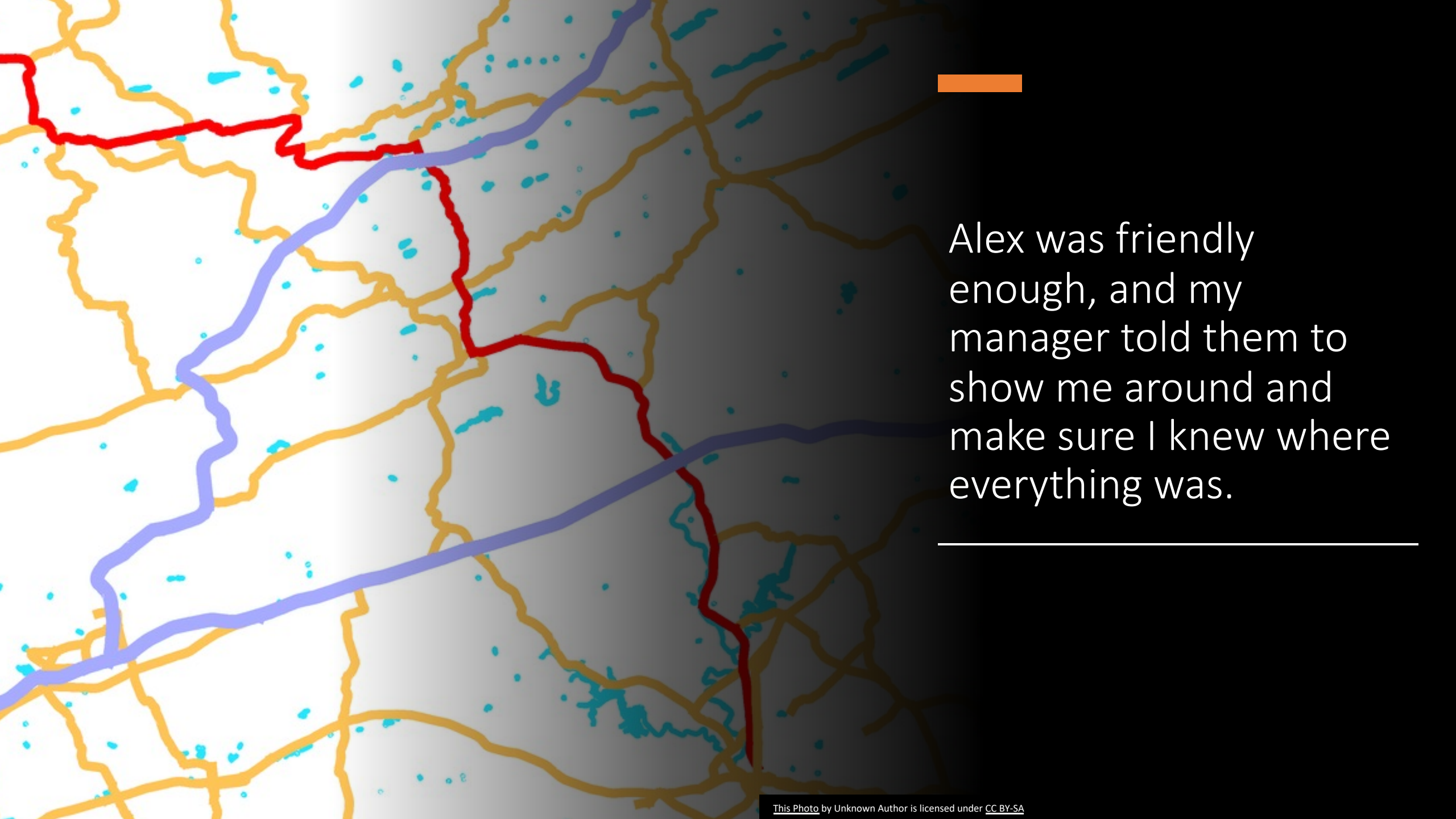
Ingrid's story 5

so it was hard to keep up with all the information they were giving me and it was a bit overwhelming.

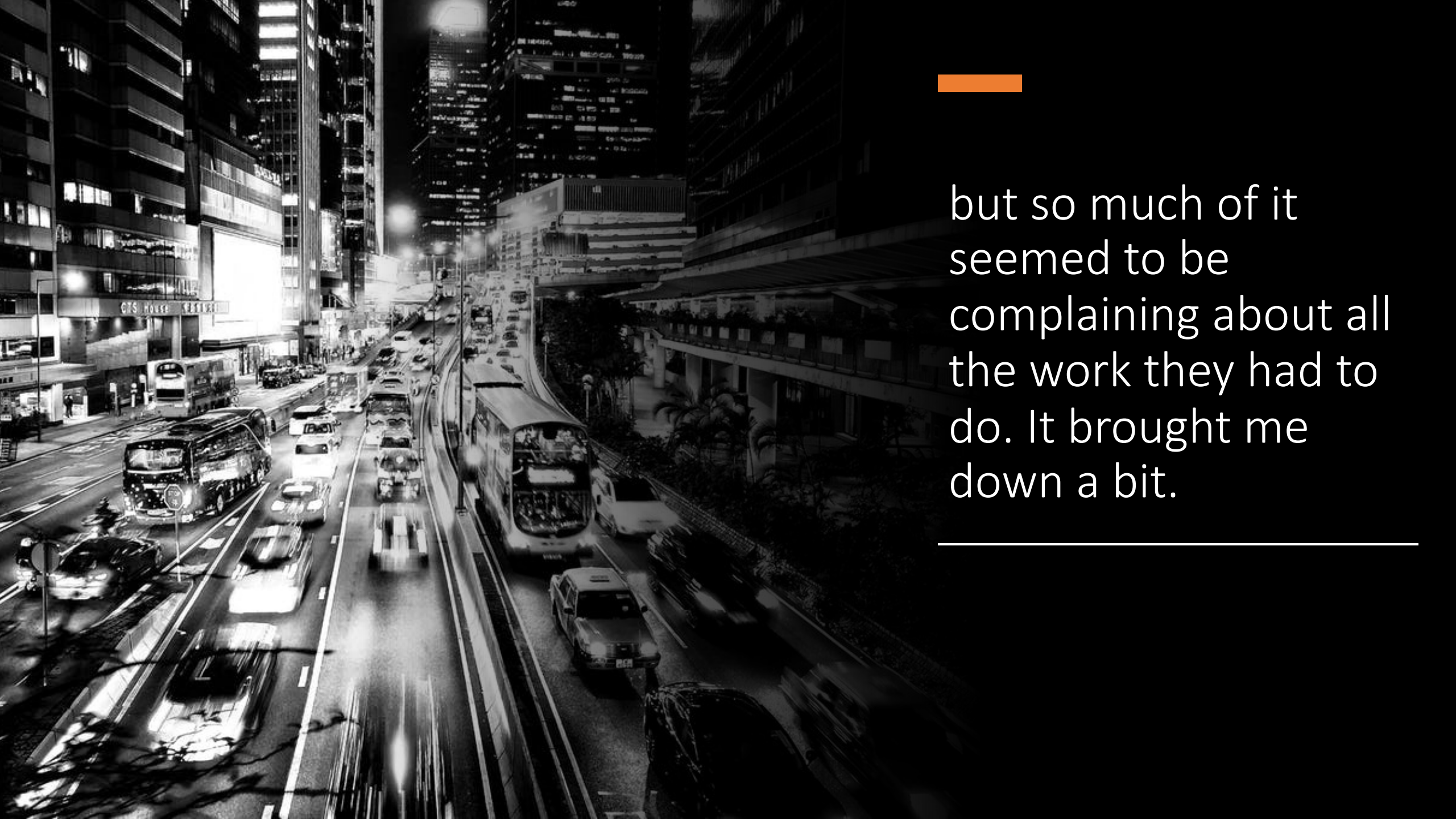


I remember on my first week, I tried to ask Alex for help but they kind of huffed and puffed a bit, like I was wasting their time.





down a bit.



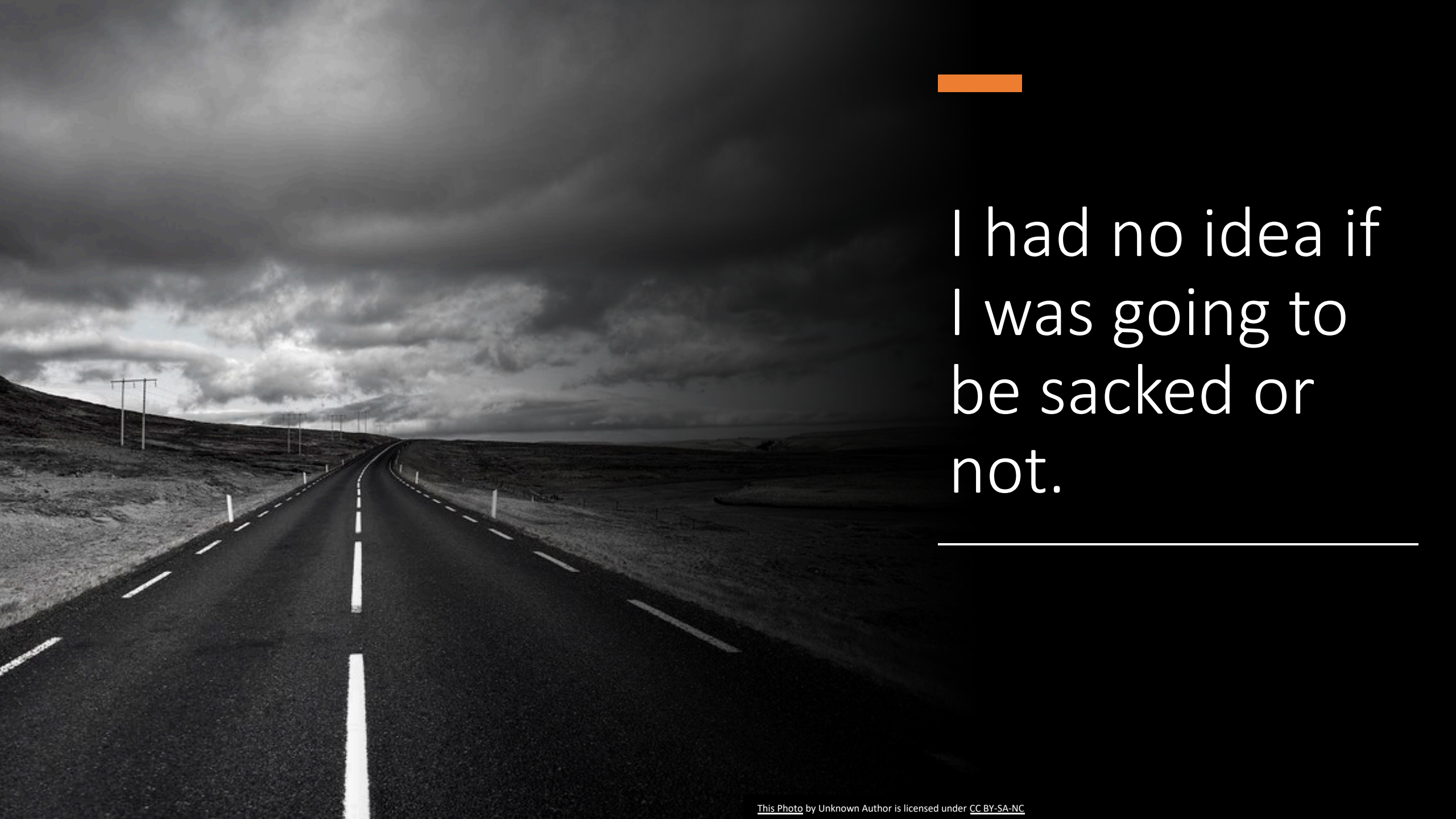
My new team-
